Working a part of the executive architect multi-disciplinary team, Viridian developed schematic documentation for the first projects to emerge from the university's comprehensive campus plan. They include a new residence hall, new student center, Athletics Center renovation, and a new home for the Kinney Center for Autism.

Each intervention was crafted to strengthen the St. Joe's brand by enhancing the safety and experience of students, faculty, staff, and visitors.

Viridian carefully reviewed each new building and building renovation to find public space opportunities which ranged from private student spaces at dormitories to public gathering spaces for institutional functions and sporting events.

We evaluated the existing campus landscape and develop a plan and palette for a robust, native ecosystem to improve air and water quality while providing habitats that make remarkable settings for student life.

Working closely with the civil engineers, Viridian found opportunities for green stormwater infrastructure and other sustainable measures that allow St. Joe's to not just meet, but exceed current regulations and deliver a campus that gives back to the surrounding community.
